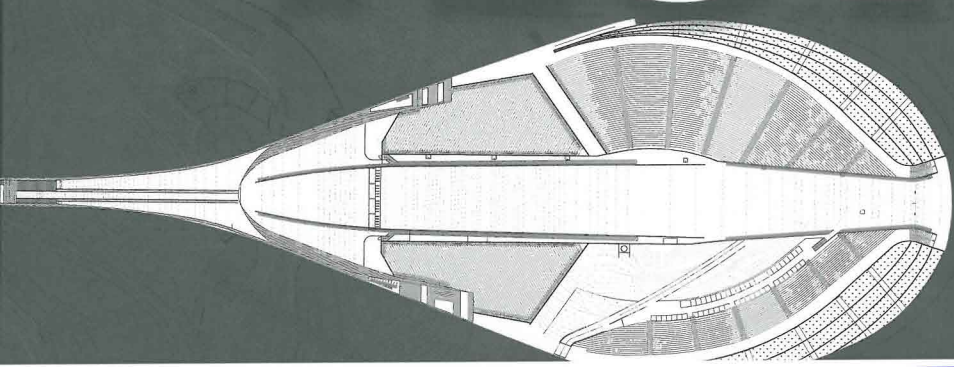
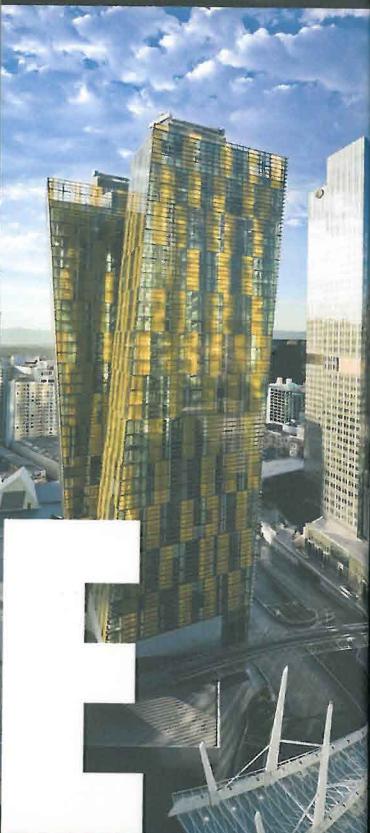

The Palace of International Forums Uzbekistan

The country's most important representative building is designed as a platform for hosting acts of state, congresses, conferences, concerts and other cultural highlights. Apart from two extensive foyers, one for official and one for public use, the building houses a 1,850-seat auditorium, conference rooms, a restaurant and a banquet hall. Cladded entirely with white Thassos marble, the building rests on a base of black granite in the heart of Tashkent, the capital of Uzbekistan. Pfarré Lighting Design has been commissioned for the interior and exterior lighting design. For the interior spaces, a large number of chandeliers and luminaires have been designed and manufactured especially for this project.
